**RE: APPEAL FOR RELEASE OF DONATED MOBILE CLINIC TO SERVE THE PEOPLE OF MWINGI AND KITUI**

After more than two years of waiting, we once again reach out to you for help. You are our last hope and the well-being of our community largely depends on you.

Imagine a mother in labor, writhing in pain, being carried on a boda boda or on a wheelbarrow for more than 20 kilometers to the nearest health clinic to deliver a baby. Now, imagine a child that has just been bitten by a snake. Their health is in danger and coming from a very poor family, this child dies because they cannot get to the hospital in time. We have cases of mothers dying in childbirth, people losing limbs to snake bites, others dying of curable disease simply because they could not access healthcare. In our community of Mwingi, this happens almost daily. It is very unfortunate that while this is happening, our donated mobile clinic, which could help by reaching people where they are and providing emergency care, lies at the port of Mombasa.

This mobile clinic was donated in good faith by *The Mtuals Foundation Inc.* of USA to help our community. Ours is a community filled with many challenges – lack of water, hunger, high levels of poverty with the majority, (more than 65%) of our people living on less than \$1 a day, low levels of education, and in addition to this, lack of emergency healthcare services, limited healthcare workers, lack of medicines, as well as inadequate health clinics. We are surrounded by challenges!

In addition to this mobile clinic wasting at the port, we are also concerned because of its long and extended storage at the port of Mombasa. It is possible that the equipment and computers inside may deteriorate and the accrued storage fees and taxes may be too high for us to bear. We are requesting that, in addition to releasing the clinic, you grant us a waiver of such fees so as to enable us get this clinic to the people.

Sir, we are banking our hopes on you. Please help our community to get this mobile clinic. It will be of great help and the people will be forever grateful. We need it. We need it urgently.




